Sunday Word - The Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B) - November 18, 2018

"And then they will see 'the Son of Man coming in the clouds' with great power and glory . . ." (Mark 13:26)

Reflection - It is easy to imagine what things must have been like at the birth of Jesus. We have eyewitness accounts: a very bright star, angel hosts singing in the heavens, gentile kings coming to worship the infant king. Don't you wish you could have been there?

Now try to imagine what the second coming will be like. No helpless infant king this time! All of Christ's enemies will be his footstool. When Jesus returns in all his glory and triumph, all nations will bow before him. Just think how much more fabulous it might be than his "humble" birth. Picture not just one star, but the entire heavens lighting up. Not just the heavenly host singing, but all of creation echoing in song. Don't you wish you could be there?

Well, there is a very good chance we will be there. It could happen tomorrow or a thousand years from now, but we could still witness such glory. Perhaps we will be among those 'rising from our sleep in the dust to shine like the splendor of the firmament' (Daniel 12). What a tremendous thing to see our savior coming in the clouds! Will you be ready?

Our readings this week foreshadow the two-fold purpose of Advent – to prepare to celebrate the Feast of the Nativity, and to prepare our hearts for the second coming. How can our music ministries help the faithful to prepare for such great joy? How can we foster hope that equals what humankind has longed for since the time of the prophets?

Prayer - Father of light and glory, Help us to keep our hearts pure for your Son's return. Keep our spirits hopeful to receive his joy. Keep our minds stayed on your path of righteousness, so we might join all of creation in welcoming our Savior once again. Come, Lord Jesus! Amen.
