Including worldviews that do not include God!






# 2. Super Saints 1500's – 1600's


Most are themselves great reformers that work tirelessly, often facing great opposition inside and outside the Church, yet they managed to transform the Church












### Root causes of the Reformation


- 1. Nationalism: Cultural, Social, Political and Economic shifts in Europe. The inevitable clash between the powers of Rome and nation states.
- 2. Problems & Abuses: Indulgences, building projects, Clergy as more civil authority than pastoral and spiritual servants.

Later, Theological Differences will lead to a wide split.


## John Wesley 1703-1791
