In 2020, the Church will celebrate Catechetical Sunday on September 20, 2020, under the theme of "I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you." On this day, catechists are formally commissioned for ministry to the community. Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the role that each baptized person plays in handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel. Catechetical Sunday is an opportunity for all to rededicate themselves to this mission as a community of faith. A commissioning will take place at the 11:15am Mass.

SACRAMENT PREPARATION:

BAPTISM: Congratulations on your decision to baptize your child! At St. John XXIII, we are happy to help your family prepare for the celebration. Baptisms are offered for registered members of Saint John XXIII and are scheduled only after the preparation process is completed by the parents. Please do not make arrangements for family members until you have actually received a date. Contact the office at (239) 561-2245 for more information or to begin the process.

FIRST COMMUNION: (also called First Eucharist and First Reconciliation) Children in first grade or above, who have expressed a desire and willingness and are attending Mass, are welcome to begin the two year process of preparing for these Sacraments. The first year consists of regular attendance at Faith Formation classes or through a Diocesan Catholic school. (Either St. Francis Xavier or St. Andrew) The second year continues those classes, but also adds in direct Sacramental Preparation (Reconciliation and Communion) sessions. Please contact Chris at 561-7499 for more information or to begin the process. Parents who home school their children must contact the office during Year I.

CONFIRMATION PREPARATION: Celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation is a two year process that begins at the start of 9th Grade and is celebrated in the Fall of 11th grade. (Older teens are certainly welcome!). Each year consists of Faith Formation through the parish Youth Group or a Diocesan Catholic school (Bishop Verot) as well as scheduled Confirmation classes and a retreat. Please note: Students from Bishop Verot must register and attend the preparation classes at the beginning of 9th grade. If you are entering the 9th grade or would like more information on our program, contact Chris at (239) 561-7499 to begin the process.

HOLY LAND COLLECTION

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The annual Pontifical Good Friday Collection did not happen as scheduled due to COVID-19. This Collection helps sustain Christianity in the Holy Land. With support of the Faithful over the years, the Franciscan Friars have maintained the sacred shrines throughout the Holy Land so that pilgrims can walk in the footsteps of Jesus.

Unfortunately, life for our brothers and sisters in this region is of great trial, as war and ongoing conflict claim the lives and livelihoods of innocent Christians. The monies raised in this Collection go to the Franciscan Custody of the Land, who in addition to overseeing the preservation of the Holy Sites, assist in parishes, provide formation and education, build homes, create jobs, take care of the elderly, and feed the hungry, all in the context of uncertainty.

As a result of the rescheduling, the Diocese of Venice will take up the collection for the Holy Land the weekend of September 19-20, 2020. Your contributions strengthen the work of the Franciscan Friars, allowing them to continue to provide for the Christian Communities that feel the weight of the Cross of Jesus on their shoulders. GIVING TO THE CFA Through a Qualified Charitable Distribution

In 2020 the law changed, requiring those 72 years old or older to begin taking a required minimum distribution (RMD) from their individual retirement account (IRA). However, only those who will turn 70½ (born on or after July 1, 1949) in 2020 or later may wait until age 72 to begin taking required distributions. If you are currently receiving RMDs (or should be) because you are over age 70½, you must continue taking these RMDs.

FOR TRADITIONAL ACCOUNTS THIS INCOME IS TAXABLE!

To avoid paying taxes on this income while also meeting the obligation of the RMD, you may designate the distribution as a gift directly from the IRA custodian to the CFA. You can donate up to \$100,000 and married couples can donate up to \$200,000 if the spouse has a separate IRA.

Matching gifts are a type of corporate philanthropy that allows donors giving smaller donations the opportunity to maximize the impact of their donation on an organization.





Are you Aware?



DEBIT CARD DANGER ZONES

Would you knowingly allow a stranger to have access to your bank account? It may seem like a silly question, but if you are using your debit card instead of your credit card to make purchases at risky locations, this is exactly what can happen. Although the two cards may look alike, their transactions are very different as purchases made with a debit card withdraw cash from your bank account, while credit card purchases use a line of credit extended to you by the issuing bank.

No matter which card you choose to use, the Lee County Sheriff's Office recommends that you never use your debit card at the following locations:

- **Outdoor Automated Teller Machines (ATM):** present a perfect opportunity for thieves to skim your debit card with devices that are placed over the real card slots or inserted into the machine. These skimmers capture information on the card's magnetic strip and are often hard to spot. Tip: Use an ATM located inside a retail outlet, banking institution or other high-trafficked, well-lit place.
- **Gas Stations:** While pretending to get gas, a fraudster can install a skimmer on a pump in just a few seconds. Pump skimming is popular with thieves because these skimmers can capture hundreds of card numbers in just one day. Tip: Use cash or credit card when filling up; however, if you must pay with your debit card, go inside the gas station and pay the cashier.
- **Online Purchases:** Just because you can order online with a debit card does not mean you should. Data breaches and malware can leave your bank account vulnerable to intrusion. Tip: For better protection and less risk against unauthorized transactions, use only a credit card for internet purchases.
- **Restaurants:** Anytime your debit card leaves your hands, fraud is possible. Restaurants, delivery orders placed over the phone, and merchants who do not take the necessary steps to safeguard your payment information can be problematic for consumers. Tip: Using a credit card or cash is the best way to keep unscrupulous employees from emptying out your bank account.

The Lee County SPECIAL NEEDS SHELTER PROGRAM will assist with transportation to a Special Needs Shelter before a hurricane and will provide shelter during the storm. You may bring your cat or dog, but you must bring your caregiver and register before the storm to receive this help.

Even if you registered for the Special Needs Shelter Program last year, you must register again for this year. Please register early because you will not be able to register within the 5-day forecast cone.

You may also receive a Special Needs Shelter Application by calling **DEBBIE QUIMBY** at Lee County Emergency Management at: **(239) 533-0640** If Debbie is away from her desk, please leave a message and she or someone else from Emergency Management will send you an application and can provide information concerning the Special Needs Shelters and transportation to them.






