Mother OF God

Mary is truly a “mother”. Not just the physical means by which our Lord entered this world, but she is also in the fullest sense mother. As mother, she always wants to present her Son to others, and to lead others to her divine Son. In the Gospels, she presented Him to the shepherds, the Magi, the Priest Simeon and Anna, and to the wedding party at Cana. She desires to do the same for each of us. When our Lord died on the Cross, standing there were His mother, Mary, and St. John the Apostle; Jesus said to Mary, “Woman, there is your son,” entrusting His widowed mother to the care of St. John; and to St. John, “There is your mother” (Jn 19:26-27). Traditionally, we have always held that here Jesus gave Mary as a mother to the Church as a whole and to each of us.

By Her Presence

Over the last 200 years, the Blessed Virgin Mary has appeared to many different people all throughout the world. By her presence in our world, the messages she gave, will be one way in which she will convert sinners.

As we learn the messages she spoke, they challenge us to reflect on how we live our life and consider how God might be inviting us to greater conversion of life. Mary’s presence, her concern for all God’s children, is one way by which she will convert sinners.

By Her Prayers

The first way Mary converts sinners is through her prayers. In a different apparition received by a Belgian immigrant in the United States back in 1859, the Blessed Mother told the seer, Adele Brise, “I am the Queen of Heaven who prays for the conversion of sinners.” Assumed body and soul into Heaven, Mary now intercedes for the world.

As the Queen Mother, she advocates for the world before the throne of her son. Isn’t it the case that the hearts of some hardened sinners have been converted and conquered by the Blessed Virgin’s love?

Mary is praying for the conversion of sinners. She’s praying for you and me. And by her prayers, she will obtain the grace of conversion from her Son, and convert sinners.

By Her Example

We meet the Blessed Virgin in the pages of the gospel. The way by which she lived her life offers us a great example.

When we are confronted with vices, we look at Mary’s virtues. When we are tempted towards pride, we remember her humility before God. When we want to be disobedient, we recall her obedience to God’s will. When impurity and unchastity confronts us, her example of purity and chastity inspires us to live similarly. When we wish to ignore the needs of our brothers and sisters in Christ, her attentiveness and generosity towards Elizabeth beckons us to respond to their needs.

Let us look to our Blessed Mother’s example and rely on her prayers. May we turn to her always as our own Mother, pleading, “Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen.”

GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY

May 8, 2022

Jesus ALWAYS Loves AND Defends HIS FLOCK

Jesus is the good shepherd who knows, loves and defends his sheep, embracing everyone without exception, Pope Francis said.

"For this is the Father's will, that no one should be lost. Christ's love is not selective; it embraces everyone," the pope said before reciting the "Regina Coeli" prayer with visitors in St. Peter's Square.

Focusing on the day's Gospel reading (Jn 10:11-18) presenting Jesus as the good shepherd, the pope said the opposite of the good shepherd is the "mercenary" — the hired hand who does not care about the flock "because they are not his."

"He does the job only for pay and is not concerned about defending them; when a wolf arrives, he flees and abandons them," the pope said.

Jesus, the true shepherd, "defends us always and saves us from so many difficult situations, dangerous situations through the light of his word and the strength of his presence that we always experience if we want to listen, every day."

But even more beautiful, he said, is Jesus knows each and every one, "we are not a 'mass,' a 'multitude' for him, no. We are unique individuals, each with his or her own story" and with his or her own value.

Knowing each person's strengths and defects, Jesus "is always ready to care for us, to heal the wounds of our errors with the abundance of his mercy," he added.

It was out of love for his sheep that he gave his life for them, and it is God's will "that no one should be lost," the pope said.

Jesus says in the Gospel that he has "other sheep that do not belong to this fold. These also I must lead, and they will hear my voice, and there will be one flock, one shepherd."


The pope said these words testify to Jesus' universal concern: "he is everyone's shepherd" and wants everyone to encounter God and receive the father's love.

Many people, even the majority of them, go to church on special occasions or never, the pope said. "But this does not mean they are not God's children; the father entrusts everyone to Jesus the good shepherd, and he gave his life for everyone."

Parish NURSING MINISTRY

A HEALING MESSAGE for body, mind and soul



There are many struggles within the world we live in such as: poverty, terrorism, war, pollution, exploitation, global pandemic etc.

What would St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta do today?

The answer is this: St. Mother Teresa would minister to the poor and vulnerable. As part of her mission, she would continue to care for those afflicted with Hansen's disease (known as Leprosy) who were shunned. The coronavirus of today is similar because it is very communicable. Those with the virus are cared for in controlled, isolated hospital settings under the care of healthcare personnel in a protective environment and need to be separated from family and friends to prevent transmission to others.

Mother Teresa did not shun those afflicted as she prayed to the Blessed Virgin and called upon Mary many times with her favorite prayer, the Memorare. She would repeat this "Flying Novena", as she called it, nine consecutive times. An example was when the Holy Father in 1984 was celebrating Mass outdoors, and as people were gathering, it began to rain very heavily. St. Teresa and her fellow sisters began to pray the "Flying Novena" of nine consecutive Memorares for beautiful weather. By the 7th set of Memorares, the umbrellas folded and by the ninth set of the "Flying Novena" umbrellas closed and the rain stopped. Mother Teresa would often pray the "Flying Novena" for a very sick child, and to obtain gasoline when fuel was running short on a night-time mission.

Here is the Memorare:

"Remember Oh most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known, that anyone who fled to your protection, implored your help or sought your intercession was left unaided. Inspired by this confidence, I fly unto you oh Virgin of Virgins, my Mother. To you I come, before you I stand, sinful and sorrowful. Oh Mother of the Word incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in your clemency hear and answer me. Amen"

Let us pray this beautiful prayer for our world, all healthcare workers, and first responders. Let's pray also for our faith community.

We must continue to practice social distancing, wash our hands frequently, wear masks when out in public, and wear disposable gloves especially when pumping gasoline.

St Mother Teresa of Calcutta, was an extraordinary human being who had her own demons of depression. She gave strength, care, and compassion to those in most need. She is a saint for our times.

One last famous quote from Mother Teresa. *"Spread love wherever you go: And let no one ever come to you without leaving happier"*

As St. John XXIII parish nurses, this is our mission: strength, care and compassion to our faith community.





MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS

Mental illnesses are medical conditions that disrupt a person's thinking, feeling, mood, ability to relate to others and daily functioning. Just as diabetes is a disorder of the pancreas, mental illnesses are disorders of the brain that often result in diminished capacity for coping with life's demands. Of the 5% of adults who experience serious mental illness each year and the 20% of adults who experience a less serious mental health condition, less than 50% will receive treatment. Symptoms of mental health disorders manifest by age 24 in 75% of cases; average length between symptom onset and treatment is eleven years while the organ that controls judgement malfunctions. This can lead to a cascade of negative life events: addictions, incarceration, unemployment, and suicide. Anosognosia is the actual physical impairment of insight due to neurological damage in the frontal lobe of the brain and explains denial and treatment resistance in those with serious mental illness. For less serious diagnoses it may be stigma (negative judgement from self or others) about brain disorders, cost, treatment programs/lack of doctors (55% of U.S. counties lack a psychiatrist), or fear of medication side effects that delay treatment. It is important for all of us to care for our brain health through proper diet, exercise, stress management and education about the mind-body connection.

At our parish Journey to Hope NAMI (National Alliance on Mental Illness) family support group, we understand the emotions that arise when behavioral symptoms show up. The common enemy is brain dysfunction, not our loved one. Instead

of confrontation which results in a defensive response, we aim to learn reflective listening. This helps with the denial that surrounds mental health, or the diverging opinions that can disrupt so much in family relationships. Unfortunately, we don't learn communication skills and often fail at listening. We easily default to opinion sharing or assuming our feelings are facts. It takes a humble spirit to really LISTEN. One resource is Dr. Xavier Amador's book "I'm Not Sick I Don't Need Help" which helps loved ones develop communication skills to approach mental health treatment as a team. His steps are: Make it safe to talk, own your fears, stop pushing your agenda, let it be, respect what you've heard, find workable problems, and write the headlines (reflect back what's been heard in a way that presents a path forward). NAMI Family to Family class teaches these and other skills (www.namilee.org)

Journey TO Hope

Brain disorders are treatable. Most people who live with serious mental illnesses can reduce the impact of their illness and achieve quality of life and independence with treatment: medication for managing symptoms, individual/group therapy, peer support (Journey to Hope is a NAMI family support group to enable family members to act effectively) and community services for housing and employment. As the Body of Christ, let's look out for one another, bust stigma, educate, encourage and offer resources and support. God's love is constant; we never walk alone. Let us share that message of hope. Our group meets May 10th at 6PM in the Parish Life Center, Room St. Therese.
