Corpus Christi SUNDAY

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is also known as the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, which translates from Latin to "Body of Christ." This feast originated in France in the midthirteenth century and was extended to the whole Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264. This feast is celebrated on the Sunday following Trinity Sunday.

This feast calls us to focus on two manifestations of the Body of Christ, the Holy Eucharist and the Church. The primary purpose of this feast is to focus our attention on the Eucharist. The opening prayer at Mass calls our attention to Jesus' suffering and death and our worship of Him, especially in the Eucharist.

At every Mass our attention is called to the Eucharist and the Real Presence of Christ in it. The secondary focus of this feast is upon the Body of Christ as it is present in the Church. The Church is called the Body of Christ because of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with his disciples. He expresses this in the gospels by using the metaphor of a body in which He is the head. This image helps keep in focus both the unity and the diversity of the Church.

The Feast of Corpus Christi is commonly used as an opportunity for public Eucharistic processions, which serves as a sign of common faith and adoration. Our worship of Jesus in His Body and Blood calls us to offer to God our Father a pledge of undivided love and an offering of ourselves to the service of others.

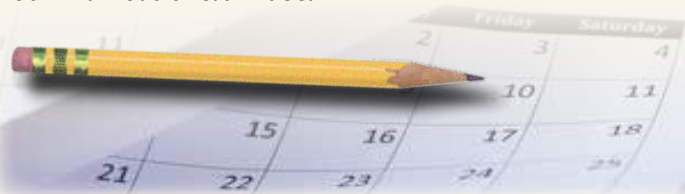

THE PATRON SAINT OF FATHERS

St. Joseph, husband of Mary and earthly father of Jesus, is the model of fatherhood. His faith and obedience to God inspired his devotion for his family. As we celebrate Father's Day today, it might be helpful to study his example. In "Five Lessons from St. Joseph," author Randy Hain points out attributes that serve as a helpful guide that St. Joseph was:

- Obedient
- Selfless
- Led By Example
- A Worker
- A Leader



"Let's look to the inspiring example of St. Joseph, Patron Saint of Fathers, workers and the Universal Church for his obedience, humility, selflessness, courage and the love he showed to Mary and Jesus. If we can emulate St. Joseph even a little each day, we will be that much closer to becoming the men you called to be.

St. Pope John Paul II highlighted St. Joseph to explain the Catholic understanding of fatherhood in his 1989 apostolic exhortation, *Redemptoris Custos* (Guardian of the Redeemer: On the Person and Mission of St. Joseph in the Life of Christ and the Church).

"Commending ourselves, then, to the protection of (St. Joseph) to whose custody God entrusted his greatest and most precious treasures, let us at the same time learn from him how to be servants of the economy of salvation. May St. Joseph become for all of us an exceptional teacher in the service of Christ's saving mission, a mission which is the responsibility of each and every member of the Church: husbands and wives, parents, those who live by the work of their hands or by any other kind of work, those called to the contemplative life and those called to the apostolate."

The significance of St. Joseph's presence in Jesus' life reminds us how important fathers are in our lives. Let us celebrate the fathers in our lives this Father's Day.

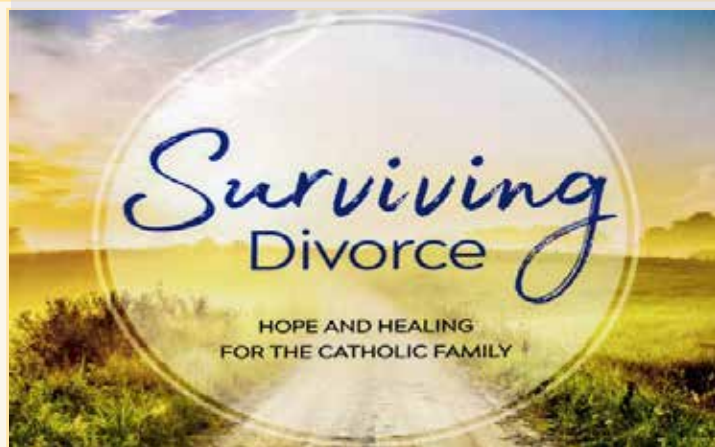

The Gift of Uncomfortable Feelings

What good is talking with a counselor? Thoughts and emotions deserve our attention. Too often, we avoid feeling emotions, then pay a price since our body and mind are connected. Fear of losing control often precedes our avoidance of emotion. Sadness, shame, embarrassment, anger, helplessness, disappointment, hurt, frustration, vulnerability are stressful to experience. But blocking uncomfortable emotion causes us problems: addictions (diseases of isolation), soulful depression (not biological yet but a disconnection from self which will lead to bodily symptoms), anxiety, numbness, and despair, which can lead to self-harm. We disconnect when we block, suppress, avoid or medicate our feelings away. Maybe we doubt our feelings, criticize ourselves for them, or have feelings about our feelings. All these forms of disconnection from ourselves leads to poor mental health.

Being aware and welcoming all emotion with curiosity and without judgement or blaming another is the road to mental health. Research shows that talking about our emotions helps us regulate our nervous system. When we share our internal reactions with another person (trained in listening & in a safe environment), we learn to label and own our feelings. When we put language (left brain) to our feelings (right brain), we integrate our left and right brain. We feel calmer, less impulsive, more in control. This ability of the brain to change is called neuroplasticity. Emotions can arise from the bottom up-as when our body registers an unconscious response to a trigger which is a survival response-warning us to avoid stress/a threatening event. Or our thoughts can precede and produce an emotion as when a thought/imagined threat puts a meaning on a triggering event that is not accurate.

Uncomfortable emotions exist to inform us. Mental wellness is knowing what we feel, and being connected at a deep level to our reality. As a result, we can be authentic, confident, resilient, and connected to others because we are aware and not sleepwalking. *“Speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become, in every respect the mature body of...the Christ.”* (Eph. 4:15)

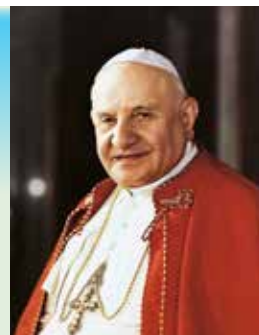

Parish NURSING MINISTRY SUMMER TIPS

Stay cool this summer and prevent heat-related illnesses when participating in outdoor activities with these tips:

Hydrate Properly Throughout the Day:

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommend that individuals who weigh less than 90 pounds need five ounces of water - that's 10 big gulps every 20 minutes.

Plan Ahead:

Wear protective clothing/sunscreen and avoid the heat during the hottest part of the day, around mid-day. Let someone know where and when you are going outdoors bringing a phone for communication emergencies.

Take Frequent Breaks:

Move to shaded or breezy areas and wear clothing to allow for increased evaporative cooling.

PREVENTING HEAT STROKE:

Heat stroke is a very seriously and potentially dangerous heat injury that requires medical attention immediately. This is the most severe form of heat-related condition that stems from milder illnesses such as heat cramps and heat exhaustion. The medical definition of heat stroke is a core body temperature of 105 degrees Fahrenheit or higher combined with central nervous system complications resulting from overexposure to high temperatures.

If you've spent a lot of time in the sun and you're experiencing any of the symptoms below, it's important to seek medical attention immediately.

Call 911 if you or others develop symptoms of heat stroke that are unable to be adequately treated.

- **Incredibly Hot Skin**
- **Dizziness and Fainting**
- **Extreme Fatigue**
- **Nausea**
- **Vomiting**
- **Rapid Heartbeat**
- **Mental Confusion**
- **Seizures**
- **Lack of Sweating**
- **Severe Headache**

Don't Fall for Phony Tech Support Call

The Lee County Sheriff's Office Fraud Line has received at least a dozen complaints from residents reporting the same information - a telephone call from someone claiming to be from the "Microsoft Refund Department".

This is a SCAM designed to trick you into believing you are due a refund from the technical support company used to protect your computer. The motive is to gain remote access of your computer in order to steal your personal data and money.

Avoid This Scam:

- Hang up on unexpected calls from anyone who claims to be tech support.
- Do not return voice messages from anyone who claims to be tech support.
- Never give control of your computer or share passwords with anyone you do not know.
- Know that Microsoft will not make unsolicited phone calls to help you with your computer.
