The Feast of The Epiphany

The Feast of the Epiphany, traditionally recognized on January 6th, is the day that the Magi or Three Wise Men visited the Christ Child and marks the end of the holiday season, thus bringing a close to the Twelve Days of Christmas. The well-known English Carol, "The Twelve Days of Christmas, was written during the era when Roman Catholics were not permitted to practice their faith openly in England. The carol was intended as a catechism song for young Catholics exposing an element of hidden meaning or a code word easily recognizable by children.

The "true love" one hears in the song is not a smitten love between a boyfriend and girlfriend, but Jesus Christ, because true Love was born on Christmas Day. The partridge in the pear tree also represents Jesus because the bird is willing to sacrifice its life if necessary to protect its young by feigning injury to draw away predators. Here is the meaning of the rest of the song:

- The TWO turtle doves are the Old and New Testaments.
- The THREE French hens signify faith, hope, and love.
- The FOUR calling birds are the four gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.
- The FIVE golden rings represent the first five books of the Old Testament, which describe man's fall into sin and the great love of God in promising a Savior.
- The SIX geese a-laying signify the six days of creation.
- SEVEN swans a-swimming are the sevenfold gifts of the Holy Spirit - Prophesy, Serving, Teaching, Exhortation, Contribution, Leadership, and Mercy.
- The EIGHT maids a-milking were the eight beatitudes.
- NINE ladies dancing are the nine fruits of the Holy Spirit - Charity, Joy, Peace, Patience (Forbearance), Goodness (Kindness), Mildness, Fidelity, Modesty, Continency (Chastity)
- The TEN lords a-leaping are the Ten Commandments.
- The ELEVEN pipers piping are the eleven faithful Apostles.
- The TWELVE drummers drumming symbolize the twelve points of belief In The Apostles' Creed.

Oh God, who by the leading of a star, manifested Your only Son to the people of the earth. Lead us, who know You now by faith, to Your presence, where we may see Your glory face to face, through *Jesus Christ our Lord;* who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Vocation/Seminary Support THIS WEEKEND


Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,







CHANGING OUR MINDS

We exist in a web of human relationships that is at once complex, life giving, and beautiful. Even in times of loneliness or despair, we remain bound to one another by the smallest daily acts, the realities of interdependence, and the mysteries of the heart. Acknowledging dependence on our Gracious God and on one another is at the heart of gratitude. Science supports a gratitude practice as a powerful antidote for depression and anxiety. Perhaps Jesus is referencing the wonder, receptivity, and openness of children when He speaks of children entering the Kingdom. We lose these childlike qualities growing up, as our egoic mind becomes our operating system. One lesson life taught me is that expectations are ego manufactured gratitude killers. By simply wanting to control outcomes, we gravitate toward resentment, the opposite of gratitude. We can't control outcomes, but our egoic mind resists that. We can become a slave to desires of our heart unless we practice the curious detachment that a daily gratitude practice produces. Ask yourself how often in a day you feel insufficiency - loved ones are not giving you enough of themselves, or you are insufficient in a role. Perhaps expectation plays out in work, health, friendship. I don't deserve my supervisor, this illness, or the way my friend betrayed me. Loss of a beloved person or pet upends us. We didn't deserve Ian. The attitude of gratitude teaches us that life is about lesson learning, and savoring good memories. We are meant to be observant of life's little moments and dependent on a higher power whose grace enables us to light a candle of hope instead of cursing the darkness. When the discipline of gratitude accompanies our human emotions as a spiritual practice, we gain freedom from the wounds and failures that life hands us. St. Paul learned to rejoice whatever hardship occurred. Faced with brokenness, gratitude heals and brings hope when there is despair. Let's prepare for a 2023 filled with gratitude (Grateful.org may help) and trust in the Providence of our God.
