






Catholic Schools Faith. Excellence. Service.

The Catholic Community Foundation is proud to offer the *Barry L. 





History Showcase

LIVING HISTORY: Eye Witness Accounts - Part 2

The beginning of a new year serves as a perfect time to reflect upon the past and savor sweet, special memories. The following remembrances of original members of St. John XXIII capture the spirit of hope, joy, and love upon which this parish was built and continues its mission of welcome to all.

"I was the first parish nurse and the first parish office volunteer. I remember making the first data entry of parishioner #0001. We all need a family since many of us come from other places. St. John's is our family. It's a church of hope, faith, and love. It started in love and continues in love." - **Colleen Glancy**

"Our first Christmas in our new Church building I was asked to provide Christmas gifts for 69 children at Jesus the Worker parish. I spoke with Fr. Sullivan and he agreed to support the project. He said we will now start a social justice ministry. Sandy, you are in charge." - **Sandy Symanski**

"Fr. Sullivan was gracious in letting us spread our wings. I found the Sunday by Sunday pamphlet which helped prepare for Sunday readings. We met in my home weekly using this tool and later moved to Barbara Catineau's home. This was an early paper attempt at the FORMED video platform we use today and that Barbara still leads. 

CATHOLIC SCHOOL **STUDENTS**

ALLOWANCE DISCOUNT

We welcome our families who are sending their children to area Catholic schools (Bishop Verot High School, St. Francis Xavier and St. Andrew grade schools) for the 2023-2024 school year. We wish to provide clarification for receiving the Catholic Faith Allowance discount for those who are registered at St. John XXIII Catholic Church and attending Catholic schools in the Fort Myers/Cape Coral area. This Catholic Faith Allowance is subject to the following criteria as set forth by our Pastor, Fr. Bob Tabbert:

The term "practicing Catholic" is applied to parents and guardians who are registered at St. John XXIII. For those registered as St. John XXIII parishioners, the following criteria will be used:

Fr. Bob Tabbert expects weekend Mass attendance. Attendance should be on a regular basis to foster the faith in your families and especially in the lives of your children.

Families must submit weekly envelopes provided when they attend weekend Mass. The amount of tithing is not factored into determining if a student receives the tuition discount set forth by the school.

Multiple envelopes for unattended Masses that are placed in the collection basket all at once will count as (1) Mass attendance. If they are left at the parish office or in the mailbox in front of the parish office, they will not be counted as Mass attendance.

If you are part of our on-line giving program or use direct payment from your bank, we ask you start and/or continue to put an envelope in the collection basket- for attendance purpose. We keep pink envelopes in the Narthex and at the back door, just add your number and name if you have left your envelope at home.

If you are registered but not receiving envelopes, please call the parish office to request them.

Grandparents' registration and attendance do not qualify a school family to receive the tuition discount unless the grandparent is the official guardian of the student.

The Catholic Faith Allowance cannot be used towards the registration fee and cannot be used towards the balance of tuition. This procedure is set forth by each school.
