# PARISH LIFE CENTER GUIDELINES

Treat Our PLC with TLC

#### **REGISTRATION:**

 Submit a registration form and have it approved by authorized staff to reserve a requested space and be added to the parish calendar.

#### **SAFETY:**

- Take care of yourself and be respectful of others.
   Document and report all accidents or injuries to a parish staff member.
- At least one authorized, trained kitchen user must be present. You must be at least 15 years old to be in the kitchen, unless special permission has been granted by authorized staff.
- All spills or trip hazards are to be contained and corrected. Report maintenance or repair needs.
- The stages are reserved for speakers, performers, and authorized personnel. Always keep children safe and off the stage.

#### **CLASSROOMS:**

- When having a meeting in one of the flex rooms, please DO NOT move any of the panels/walls. Those are to be moved by trained staff for security purposes. If you need a smaller room than what is provided please advise when requesting the room for your meeting. Also if any tables or chairs are moved please return everything back to where it goes.
- Classrooms are food-free zones. No food or drinks are allowed in the five stand-alone classrooms.

#### **UPKEEP:**


- Keep walls, windows, and doors free of decorations.
   Free-standing banners, easels, and portable walls are available for approved requests.
- Table decorations are allowed, including weighted balloons. All decorations must be removed during event clean-up.
- Only floor cord protectors, not tape, are to be used for extension cords.
- Refrain from placing feet on walls.

#### **CLEAN UP:**

- Return the PLC to pristine condition after your event. All trash must be removed.
- Tables/chairs must be returned to original placement.
- Do not leave extra items without staff approval.

#### TECHNOLOGY:

- Air conditioning and heating will be controlled only by authorized staff.
- Audio/visual equipment is to be operated by authorized and properly trained personnel.



I was born in Savannah Beach, GA, 1943, where my father volunteered to do the ballast for navy ships during WW II. Both my parents were born in Italy, my father in Naples and my mom in Asti Piedmont.

We moved to Brooklyn, NY when I was 9 months old. Even though I left Brooklyn when I was 18, Brooklyn totally is a part of me.

At the age of 18 I began my 9 year preparation for the priesthood in the Catholic Foreign Mission Society of American (MARYKNOLL). After ordination I was assigned to Korea. When my father had a severe stroke I returned to the US and began to work in the Diocese of Bridgeport. After serving in three parishes I was appointed Pastor of St. Gregory the Great in Danbury, CT. I was Pastor there for 27 years, retiring in August of 1990. I moved to Fort Myers, Florida, September 1 of 1990 and began my service to St. John XXIII and the parish community.

### Sean's Story by: by Joanne Halt. M.A.

Florida has the nation's third-largest population of people who are homeless. Many who have a mental health condition and are homeless come through the doors of St. Martin De Porres Outreach. One is 53 year old Sean from Richmond VA, who has lived unhoused in our area for 20+ years. His story is one of co-occurring disorders (mental health and alcohol use disorder). He experienced violence and instability in his home as a child. His mom died when he was 18 and already using alcohol to self-medicate. As I listened to Sean, his high level of stress in childhood guaranteed a mental health disorder. For those, who like Sean, lack support, diagnosis and treatment rarely occurs early enough to change the course of their lives; consequences of remaining untreated are incarceration or homelessness.

Sean would score high in the ACES (Adverse Childhood Experiences) questionnaire. It asks questions about childhood experiences for medical/mental health assessment covering: physical, emotional or sexual abuse, parental neglect, conditions of instability in the household or traumatic school/community events while a minor. These events affect a child's whole body-brain development, immune systems, and stress-response systems. Brain changes then affect a child's attention, decision-making, and emotion regulation which can lead to trouble forming stable relationships and ability to be employed. Being unhoused is just the next step. This path of untreated trauma/substance use disorder exists for many of SMDP's guests. Brain impacts continue when the unhoused face constant vigilance to protect themselves releasing more stress hormones. Sean has been beaten, run over by a car, suffering many severe injuries. After treatment for a physical injury he was patched up, given an Uber ride paid for by the hospital and dropped off near the woods. By public policy, we agree that some folks are hopeless. Unhoused people have little value in a society placing prime value on productivity and consumerism.

SMDP is a Christ candle, a place of refuge where folks like Sean come to be fed and listened to, opening a person's heart to trust and hope. Before the unhoused can use the existing chain of services, supportive relationship must occur. SMDP called Centerstone, our local FACT (Florida Assertive Community Treatment agency) who sent a caseworker. Catholics Charities helped with document assistance so he could receive necessary paperwork to qualify for Arbor Village, a CASL (Community Assisted Supported Living) facility. None of us thrived or succeeded on our own; we achieved what we did due to those who nurtured us. We received strengths such as: empathy, resilience, gratitude, self-compassion, confidence, determination, courage, wisdom, and generosity from others.


Christ asks us to see the 'Jesus in disguise' in those who often are seen as less deserving. The reign of God that Jesus proclaimed includes a special place for those deemed "unworthy." This core gospel message needs our attention and energy today because lack of shelter for the unhoused is a major issue in our community. How can we profess to love the unseen God when we neglect those we do see, who lack basic shelter? May those serving at SMDP be blessed a hundredfold.
