CATECHETICAL SUNDAY

September 21, 2025

United States Conference of Catholic Bishops



In 1935, the Vatican published On the Better Care and Promotion of Catechetical Education, a document that asks every country to acknowledge the importance of the Church's teaching ministry and to honor those who serve the Christian community as catechists. For the first few years after Catechetical Sunday was established, national catechetical congresses were held in conjunction with the celebration. Beginning in 1971, the USCCB's Department of Education began producing materials to help parishes celebrate the event at the local level. When the Committee on Catechesis, now named the Committee of Evangelization and Catechesis, was named by the Conference as a standing Committee, it continued to publish Catechetical Sunday materials each year. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has designated the third Sunday in September as Catechetical Sunday.

Meaning

The word might be more familiar than you think. Many Catholics have used the word "catechism" for years, and they know it has something to do with the compendium of the Church's teachings. The root word, "catechesis," is from a Greek word meaning "to echo, or resound." Catechesis is the act of resounding or bringing the Church's teachings to the world. A catechist is one who teaches in the name of the Church.

Recognition

Catechesis is a distinct and special ministry in the Church. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church makes clear, "Catechesis is intimately bound up with the whole of the Church's life . . . her inner growth and correspondence with God's plan depend essentially on catechesis". This ministry of teaching in the name of the Church has a profound dignity, which is why catechists are formally commissioned by the Church. It is only fitting that we set aside a day to highlight this ministry and invite the entire church community to think about our responsibility to share our faith with others.

Parents are truly the primary catechists of their children. They prepare the soil and plant the first seeds of faith. On Catechetical Sunday, we not only highlight the work of catechists in parishes and schools, but we also commend parents and guardians and encourage them to take seriously their role of making their Catholic households a place where faith is passed on to the next generation. This is why the rite of blessing of catechists used on Catechetical Sunday includes an optional blessing of parents and guardians.

Untreated mental health conditions can lead to suicide. Too many people experience mental health related distress without the support and care they need. Stressors such as: loss of a job, financial stress, death of a loved one, divorce, substance abuse, trauma, chronic illness, legal troubles, or any cause for shame or rejection can be a trigger. Suicide is now the second leading cause of death in 15-24 year olds and the third leading cause of death for 10-24 year olds. Suicide is the second leading cause of death in veterans under age 45.

We put a lot of effort into knowing the signs of cancer so we can catch it at stage 1. What if we were that diligent about catching mental health disorders early? How many lives might be saved? Some of the warning signs for death by suicide include: hopelessness and anger/ irritability; dramatic changes in mood, appetite or sleep patterns; and talking about death or suicide. Don't be afraid to ask your loved one or friend if they have thought about ending their emotional pain by going to sleep and never waking up (soft approach) or have thought about committing suicide (direct approach).

If the answer is yes, stay with them. Tell them you care about them, you don't want to lose them and you think that if they knew of other options for dealing with their pain, they would not consider doing this. Know your local resources and help the person receive professional care. Park Royal Hospital (9241 Park Royal Dr.) offers free walk in evaluations for mental health conditions 24/7. Our Lee County Mobile Crisis Unit (888-395-44320) is an option for in home assessment and referral to mental health services. The National Suicide and Crisis Lifeline is #988 and can offer support by phone until a referral to local resources is achieved. Be the courageous Good Samaritan who sees the need and helps a fellow traveler in life. Be Christ's disciple and spread hope: "I have come that that they may have life, and have it to the full." - John 10:10


